COM 1971: Internal Medicine I

The clinical clerkship in Internal Medicine is a required 4-week Core clerkship. This clerkship is designed to provide the student with an understanding of Internal Medicine through the integration of didactic knowledge and clinical experiences. Students will receive exposure to a diverse community of patients in both ambulatory and required inpatient settings. The curriculum content is delivered to students via the learning management system web site.
